Sawgrass Sanctuary Park is an environmental interpretive passive park constructed on a 21-acre parcel located at the Southwest corner of Interstate 75 and State Road 84 within the City of Sunrise. This park includes the creation of an enormous wetland as well as picnic pavilions, interpretive stations, animal footprint teaching pads, boardwalk with porthole viewing terminals, an observation platform, fishing pier, canoe trails and even a concert platform. The Chappell Group, Inc. in conjunction with Craven Thompson & Associates, Inc. was responsible for the design and permitting of all aspects of wetland park and canoe trail.
